

Role of the Commission

- •To promote a coordinated, municipal-wide approach to the provision of recreation opportunities.
- Support community, municipal recreation organizations in the delivery of programs and services.
- Support community recreation associations in development and maintenance of community recreation facilities.
- To develop and sustain effective leadership and volunteers which support recreation, physical activity, sport and healthy active lifestyles.
- Liaison to Municipal Council on recreation related matters.
- Continually evaluate programs, services and approaches to ensure they are meeting the needs
 of the municipality.

Recreation Program Support - Supporting community organizations to initiate new recreation programs that are accessible to the municipality.



Mother's Day is an occasion which is celebrated in various parts of the world annually on the second Sunday of May to express respect, honor, and love towards mothers and mother figures. The day is an event to honor the contribution of mothers, acknowledge the efforts of maternal bonds and the role of mothers in our society.

Mother figures may include step-mothers, mothers-in-law, grandmothers, aunts, guardians (eg. foster parents) and family friends.

History

The modern holiday of Mother's Day was first celebrated in 1908, when Anna Jarvis held a memorial for her mother, Ann Reeves Jarvis, at St. Andrew's Methodist Church in Grafton, West Virginia. St. Andrew's Methodist Church now holds the International Mother's Day Shrine. Her campaign to make Mother's Day a recognized holiday in the United States began in 1905, the year her mother, Ann Reeves Jarvis, died. Ann Reeves Jarvis had been a peace activist who cared for wounded soldiers on both sides of the American Civil War, and created Mother's Day Work Clubs to address public health issues.

Anna Jarvis wanted to honor her mother by continuing the work she started and to set aside a day to honor all mothers because she believed a mother is "the person who has done more for you than anyone in the world".

In 1908, the U.S. Congress rejected a proposal to make Mother's Day an official holiday. However, owing to the efforts of Anna Jarvis, by 1911 all U.S. states observed the holiday, with some of them officially recognizing Mother's Day as a local holiday (the first being West Virginia, Jarvis' home state, in 1910). In 1914, Woodrow Wilson signed a proclamation designating Mother's Day, held on the second Sunday in May, as a national holiday to honor mothers.

Pecan Parmesan Chicken Bites

A simple and tasty take on chicken fingers!

Ingredients:

- 3 (about 1 ½ lb / 600 g) boneless skinless chicken breasts
- 2 tbsp (30 mL) maple syrup
- 1 tbsp (15 mL) canola oil
- ½ cup whole wheat panko breadcrumbs
- 1/3 cup (75 mL) finely chopped pecans
- 1/3 cup (75 mL) parmesan cheese, grated
- ¼ cup (60 mL) flax seeds, ground
- · 2 tsp (10 mL) garlic powder
- · 1 tsp (5 mL) dried oregano leaves
- ¼ tsp (1 mL) each salt and fresh ground pepper



Directions:

- 1. Cut chicken into cubes or strips and place in a large bowl. Drizzle with maple syrup and oil and coat evenly; set aside.
- In a large resealable bag, combine breadcrumbs, pecans, cheese, flax seeds, garlic powder, oregano, salt and pepper.
- 3. Add a few chicken pieces at a time to bag and shake to coat.
- 4. Place onto parchment paper lined baking sheet and repeat with remaining chicken and coating.
- 5. Bake in preheated 475°F (246°C) oven for about 15 minutes or until golden and chicken is no longer pink inside.

These chicken bites can be re-purposed the next day and put into pita pockets, wraps or in a salad. The ground flax in the recipe adds a boost of healthy fats and fibre. Substitute ground pecans for other nuts such as walnuts or pistachios.
