## Happy Father's Day



Father's Day is an occasion which is celebrated in various parts of the world annually on the third Sunday of June to express respect, honour, and love towards fathers and father figures. The day is an event to honour the contribution of fathers and the role of fathers in our society.

Father figures may include step-fathers, fathers-in-law, grandfathers, uncles, guardians (eg. foster parents) and family friends.

### History

After Anna Jarvis' successful promotion of Mother's Day in Grafton, West Virginia, the first observance of a day honouring fathers was held on July 5, 1908, in Fairmont, West Virginia. Grace Golden Clayton was mourning the loss of her father, who was one of the 362 men who were killed in the Monongah Mining Disaster of December 1907. 250 of them were fathers, leaving around a thousand fatherless children. Clayton suggested that her pastor Robert Thomas Webb honour all those fathers. This was the country's first ever event to strictly honour fathers, but it was just a one-and-done thing. Nothing really came of it.

The following year, however, a woman named Sonora Smart Dodd started her quest to establish Father's Day as a national holiday after hearing a church sermon about the newly recognized Mother's Day. Dodd held her father in great esteem. Dodd was one of six raised by her single father and thought fathers should be honoured the same way as mothers. After a year of petitioning her local community and government, Dodd's home state of Washington celebrated its first official Father's Day on June 19, 1910. Dodd then approached the Spokane Ministerial Alliance and suggested her own father's birthday, of June 5, as the day of honour for fathers. The Alliance chose the third Sunday in June instead.

Over time, the idea of Father's Day became popular and embraced across the nation. In 1916, President Woodrow Wilson sent a telegraph to Spokane praising Father's Day services. William Jennings Bryan was another early admirer of the observance. In 1966, President Lyndon B. Johnson signed a presidential proclamation declaring the third Sunday of June as Father's Day. In 1972. President Nixon established a permanent national observance of Father's Day to be held on the third Sunday of June each year.





## A Note on Food Safety

- Thaw frozen leftovers in the fridge (not the counter).
- Re-heat leftovers to 165°F check using a food thermometer.
  - Only reheat leftovers one time. Do not refreeze thawed leftovers.
- Keep leftovers in the fridge for a maximum of 2-3 days. Freeze if storing longer.
  - Ensure soups, gravies, sauces are brought to boil before you eat them.

## **Lovely Leftovers**

Getting creative with leftovers can help you save time, money and help decrease food waste. Planning to use leftovers can help you prioritize key nutrients that we need for good health.

### Vegetables and Fruit:

- Peel & freeze overripe bananas and use in loafs, muffins and smoothies.
- Add any combination of leftover cooked vegetables into a pasta dish, casserole or quiche.
  - Use leftover stir-fried vegetables in a wrap or omelette

### Grains:

- Chill leftover pasta for pasta salad, soups or casseroles.
- Use extra quinoa, rice or barley in a grain bowl, soup or casserole.
  - Make individual sized pizzas using tortillas, English muffins or pita breads for the crust.

### Protein Foods:

- Sauté ground beef, use some in a casserole and freeze the rest for chili, pasta sauce or stuffed peppers.
  - Bake larger pieces of meat such as whole chicken, ham or beef. Serve hot and use leftovers in stirfries, soups, casseroles, sandwiches or salads.

# Pan-fried halloumi cheese (if using):

Cut halloumi into 1 cm slices. Heat a non-stick pan on medium heat. Add slices of halloumi and cook for 1 to 2 minutes on each side until golden brown. If you don't have a non-stick pan, use a little bit of oil to prevent sticking.

### 2. Dressing:

In a small bowl, whisk together oil, lemon juice, oregano,salt, pepper and garlic; set aside.

### 3. Power Bowl:

Divide quinoa,tomatoes, cucumber, yellow pepper,and salmon (or tuna) among 4 bowls. Top with cheese, onion, and olives. Drizzle with dressing.

### Dressing:

- Oil 1/3 cup (75 mL)
- Fresh lemon juice 3 tablespoons (45 mL)
- Dried oregano 1 teaspoon (5 mL)
- · Salt and fresh ground pepper 1/4 teaspoon (1 mL) each
- · Garlic, pressed 1 clove

### Power Bowl:

- Quinoa, barley or brown rice, cooked 2 cups (500 mL)
- Grape tomatoes, halved 2 cups (500 mL)
- Sliced, halved English cucumber 2 cups (500 mL)
- · Sweet yellow pepper, cut into bite-size pieces 1
- Water-packed salmon 2 cans (each about or tuna, drained 6 oz / 170 g)
- Small cubed Havarti cheese 1 cup (250 mL) or pan-fried halloumi cheese
- Red onion, diced ¼ cup (60 mL)
- · Kalamata olives, halved and pitted 8




