Louis Riel Day - February 16, 2026



Louis Riel

(born October 22 1844 in Saint-Boniface, Red River Settlement; died November 16 1885 in Regina, SK)

Louis Riel Day is an annual general holiday in the Canadian province of Manitoba on the third Monday of February.

It commemorates the life of Louis Riel, a politician who represented the Métis people's interests. Many people have a day off work and school and many businesses, organizations and stores are closed. In some communities, stores are open after noon. Public transport services may follow Sunday or holiday timetables. In rural areas, there may be no services.

Louis Riel Day gives people in Manitoba the chance to enjoy some time with their families, to take a short winter break or to take part in outdoor sports events.

It is also an opportunity to learn about the Métis people's culture, language, heritage and ancestral homeland.

July 6 1885, a formal charge of treason was laid against Riel. July 20 1885, his trial began in Regina. The jury pronounced Riel guilty and he was sentenced to death.

November 16 1885, Louis Riel was executed for leading the Northwest Resistance in defence of Métis rights at the North-West Mounted Police barracks in Regina. Following the execution, Riel's body was returned to his mother's home in St. Vital, where it lay in state. Later, his remains were laid to rest in the churchyard of the Saint-Boniface Cathedral in Winnipeg.

Riel still remains the most famous Métis leader and an important figurehead for Métis people in Western Canada.

His grave, as well as his home, are both well-visited historic sites.



Kids in the Kitchen / Food Exposure

- It's estimated that 40% of Canadians that eat out regularly do so because of convenience, feel there is no time to cook, or do not know how to cook.
- Getting kids in the kitchen at an early age helps to develop the cooking skills that they need to feel confident in the kitchen.
- Having kids help in the kitchen also helps to increase the acceptability of food. The more a child sees, feels and touches the food, the easier it becomes to eat it.
- Even kids 2 - 3 yrs old can have fun washing fruits and vegetables or smelling herbs and spices.

Yogurt Bark

Ingredients

- 3/4 cups (175 mL) frozen mango cubes, thawed
- 3 tbsp (45 mL) water
- 1 1/2 cups (375 mL) vanilla Greek yogurt
- 6 – 8 large strawberries, diced
- 1 handful of pumpkin seeds
- 1 handful of unsweetened coconut strips



Directions

- Mix together the mango cubes and water. With an immersion blender, purée until smooth and evenly combined.
- Line a baking sheet with parchment paper.
- Spread the yogurt in a layer approximately one centimeter thick.
- Pour the fruit purée over the yogurt. With the tip of a knife, marble the mixture using circular motions.
- Sprinkle with toppings: strawberries, pumpkin seeds and coconut strips.
- Place in freezer until the yogurt is completely frozen, about two hours.
- Break the bark into pieces and enjoy! The bark can be stored in the freezer!

Kids can help by:

- spreading the yogurt
- sprinkling the toppings
- suggesting new and interesting fruit/nut/seed combinations
